Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The current fee for the practical examination is \$1,435 for each applicant to cover the costs of administering the examination. If the examination is eliminated, the costs will be eliminated. The associated revenues that are collected to cover the costs will also be eliminated. DSPS has administered or will administer the examination to 47 applicants (12 applicants in 2012 and 35 in April 2013).

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Repeal of WIS Stat. 446.02(3)(a) will result in costs and associated revenues being eliminated.
