Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Assembly Bill 27 would prohibit a state agency from contracting to provide legal services for the state on a contingent basis unless the governor makes a written determination that entering into such a contract is cost-effective and in the public interest. The bill further imposes limits on aggregate contingency fees based on recovery if the governor has allowed such a contract.

The fiscal effect of this bill is indeterminate as the department has not contracted for legal services on a contingent basis nor does it have any data that would identify the impact on state operations for any state agency. It is unlikely that such a contract would have a fiscal impact regardless.
