Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB 399 creates career and technical education incentive grants that would be awarded to K12 school districts in the amount of \$1,000 per pupil awards for each pupil who completes an approved, industry-recognized certification and who graduates from high school in the school district.

AB 399 affects the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) through the requirement that the WTCS annual confer with the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development to identify industries and occupations that face workforce shortages or shortages of adequately trained entry-level workers. While there are WTCS staff and resource demands that will be needed to comply with the requirement to identify industries and occupations with workforce shortages, we anticipate being able to fulfill these additional responsibilities using available, existing resources.
