### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill, if enacted, will provide a procedure for the surrender of firearms by a person if subject to a domestic abuse injunction, a child abuse injunction, or if the court determines the person may use a firearm to harm another or endanger public safety.

Prosecutors do not expect this bill to have much, if any, of a fiscal impact on their offices because these injunctions pertain to civil, not criminal, cases. The bill's intent is more of a court function requiring another hearing to ensure the surrender of firearms to the sheriff.

### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Prosecutors do not anticipate any significant long-term fiscal impact on their office, should this bill be enacted.
