Manufacture and sale of food and beverage containers that contain bisphenol A and providing penalties									

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law prohibits the manufacture or sale at wholesale of a child's container that contains bisphenol A (BPA). In addition, retailers are prohibited from selling a child's container that contains BPA. The bill also prohibits the manufacture or wholesale of food containers that contain BPA, unless the food container is conspicuously labelled as containing BPA.

Prosecutors anticipate a slight increase in their workload should the bill be enacted, but after violators initially have been prosecuted, they anticipate there will be no fiscal effect on their offices.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

If the bill is enacted, prosecutors anticipate no long-term fiscal impact on their offices.
