## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits the manufacture or wholesale sale of food containers that contain BPA. The bill defines "food container" as a container in which any food or beverage is intended to be enclosed for retail sale. A similar prohibition in current law against baby bottles or spill-proof cups that contain BPA is enforced by DATCP.

The fiscal effect of this bill on DATCP would be minimal. DATCP has not received complaints or other evidence of violations of the current law. Therefore, DATCP has not incurred significant costs enforcing the current law. The agency occasionally receives informal questions and requests for clarification, but the cost of providing this information is minimal.

If this bill were enacted, DATCP anticipates a high level of industry compliance, and minimal enforcement costs.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
