Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This proposal is intended to meet the goal of allowing fuel trucks, up to 26,000 pounds gross vehicle weight rating, the ability to deliver propane or heating fuel during an energy emergency regardless of lower weight postings by DOT or local highway authorities. Any person operating a motor vehicle under this authorization must, to the extent practicable, deliver propane or heating oil at times of the day when the highways used are the least vulnerable.

It is unknown what gross vehicle weight these vehicles will be traveling at, as well as what the local postings are on the roads being traveled. Due to these unknowns, any impact on local roadways is indeterminate.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
