## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill changes portions of the regulations and penalties relating to the packaging and sale of oleoresin of capsicum, commonly referred to as the pepper in pepper spray.

The bill eliminates some of the packaging requirements for persons who sell oleoresin of capsicum. It also eliminates penalties for persons who leave an unsold device or container in a place where customers might have access to it. It also eliminates penalties for certain violations involving persons under the age of 18.

The changes made by the bill are likely to result in fewer court cases being brought that involve oleoresin of capsicum. An accurate estimate of the change in costs is impossible with existing data. It is not expected to have a significant impact on the court system.
