## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill eliminates or modifies some of the regulations pertaining to the packaging and sale of oleoresin of capsicum, known as the peper in pepper spray.

District Attorneys have indicated that currently they do not have many pepper spray violation cases. Because this bill would remove some of the current violations, it will be less likely that a violation will occur. Should this bill be enacted, prosecutors do not anticipate a fiscal impact on their offices.
