Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Senate Bill 249 requests an expenditure of \$90,000 from the general fund for payment of a claim against the state by Robert Lee Stinson. Mr. Stinson was wrongfully imprisoned and was cleared of his charges in July 2009. Mr. Stinson petitioned the Claims Board for compensation of \$129,000, which was the equivalent of \$5,000 per year (23 years) of wrongful imprisonment and \$14,000 in attorney fees on behalf of the Wisconsin Innocence Project, which provided assistance to the claimant.

Per the statutes under section 775.05, the Claims Board may not exceed a total of \$25,000 per award, nor may an award be based upon a rate of compensation exceeding \$5,000 per year. In December 2010, the Claims Board awarded Mr. Stinson \$25,000 and recommended that the claimant be paid an additional \$90,000 for wrongful imprisonment for a total of \$115,000, which is the amount of Mr. Stinson's petition less the \$14,000 for attorney fees.
