Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The proposed legislation would require a limited lines travel license to sell travel insurance. The bill would require a licensed producer to supervise and train those selling travel insurance inside a travel agency.

This bill tracks closely with the National Association of Insurance Commissioner's model act on travel insurance. The new process creates additional requirements on the agent, and the travel agency but will not require new processes for OCI. This is not anticipated to have any fiscal impact on OCI.
