Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2015 AB 109, makes a number of technical changes to the law authorizing towns located in a county with a population of at least 485,000 to withdraw from county zoning, including changes related to the timing of notices to withdraw from county zoning and elimination of the requirement to file an official map.

Local Fiscal Effect:

Provisions of AB 109 that change the timing of notices to withdraw from county zoning are not expected to have a local fiscal effect. Provisions of the bill that eliminate the requirement of a town to submit a certified official map are expected to reduce town costs. The range of costs to provide a certified official map and the number of towns that may elect to withdraw from zoning under s. 60.23 (34) (b) 2, from which the requirement was eliminated, are unknown. Therefore, the fiscal effect is indeterminate.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
