## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill requires the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection to issue licenses that authorize the growing and processing of industrial hemp. The bill further requires the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection to obtain a criminal history search from the Department of Justice for each applicant to determine whether the applicant has been convicted of violating the controlled substances law.

The Department of Justice will collect \$7 per criminal history search requested by the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection. The additional workload and revenue is indeterminate and will depend on the number of applicants.
