## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would create 230.35(4)(b)2 relating to an optional holiday for state employees to observe the birthday of Cesar E. Chavez. Under the bill, if March 31 falls on a day on which the offices of a state agency are open, the appointing authority of the state agency is required to permit any employee of the state agency to receive that day as a paid holiday in lieu of receiving a paid holiday on one of the other paid holidays provided to state employees. The bill also provide that the appointing authority may permit an employee to receive March 31 as a paid holiday only if the operations of the state agency are maintained at least at a minimum level.

This bill will not have a fiscal impact on the University of Wisconsin (UW) System because UW is no longer governed by Wis. Stat. 230 for leave benefits. However, if this bill is passed, UW would likely review its leave policies to determine if it would want to align with other state agencies in this regard.
