### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill allows a rural ambulance service provider to upgrade its service level to the highest level of license of any emergency medical technician who is staffing that ambulance if the Department Medical Director approves a proposal submitted to him or her by the rural ambulance service provider.

Under the bill, the Agency would update operational plans and protocols accordingly, but does not expect a fiscal impact on the state or local level.
