Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires the Legislative Audit Bureau to maintain a toll-free number for the purpose of receiving reports of mismanagement, abuse, or neglect at the state veterans homes from the veterans' homes employees, residents, or families of residents. The bill requires the Bureau to relay these reports to the appropriate Bureau employee for investigation or refer the reports to a department to conduct the investigation. The bill includes confidentiality provisions related to the informant and to any investigation that is not yet completed.

The Bureau currently maintains the Fraud, Waste, and Mismanagement Hotline and has the infrastructure to receive reports. Reports related to the state veterans homes have been received and investigated by staff for the hotline. Therefore, it appears that the Bureau could absorb the costs of receiving reports related to veterans homes.
