Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under the bill, alcohol beverage, cigarette, and tobacco permit (state) and license (municipal) applications may not require more than one signature on behalf of the applicant. The bill prohibits any requirement that an applicant's signature be notarized. Under the bill, any person who knowingly provides materially false information on such a license or permit may subject to a civil forfeiture of no more than \$1,000.

The department estimates that the bill will have a minimal fiscal impact at the state level. State administrative costs and changes to permit forms and publications can be absorbed with existing budget authority.

The bill would result in one-time administrative costs for local governments to update license forms.
