#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, in order to renew a credential issued by the Board of Nursing an individual must complete and submit with the application for renewal a nursing workforce survey developed by the Department of Workforce Development(DWD); and pay a nursing workforce survey fee of \$4. Moneys received from survey fees are used to fund a grant to a statewide nursing center and to pay for costs associated with the survey.

This bill makes completion of the nursing workforce survey and payment of the survey fee optional. Under the bill, an applicant for a renewal of a credential issued by the board may, but is not required to, complete the survey and pay the fee.

If the bill is enacted DWD projects that zero individuals will voluntarily pay the \$4 fee and less than 10 percent of individuals currently projected to complete the survey will do so voluntarily. Although the average annual revenue will drop from \$210,000 to \$0, the bill does not repeal the requirement in 106.30(2) and (3) that DWD collect and analyze nursing survey data and report the results of the survey.

Current law provides for DWD to retain 12 percent of the fee revenues collected to apply to costs for administering and reporting survey results, or approximately \$25,000 annually. If this bill is adopted, then \$25,000 in lost revenue for DWD administration costs, cost of this statutorily required activity will need to be paid from DWD's 20.445(1)(a) GPR funds, thus displacing funding for other activities.

In addition, without revenue DWD will be unable to meet the statutory requirement in 106.30(5)(a) to award grants to a nonprofit statewide nursing center to "develop strategies to ensure that there is a nursing workforce that is adequate to meet the current and future health care needs of this state."

#### **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

Survey administration and reporting costs, totaling approximately \$25,000 will be shifted from revenue in 20.445 (1)(km) to GPR in 20.445(1)(a).
