### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection to issue licenses that authorize the growing and processing of industrial hemp.

Prosecutors theorize they might see a slight increase in DATCP referred cases. Therefore, the fiscal effect on their offices is indeterminate.

### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The long range effect of this legislation is indeterminate for the reasons cited above.
