Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill seeks to prohibit discrimination on the basis of a person's gender identity or gender expression. It also adds sexual orientation as protected from discrimination in certain other laws.

Current law prohibits discrimination in employment, housing, and the equal enjoyment of a public place of accommodation on the basis of a person's sex or sexual orientation. Current law also prohibits the University of Wisconsin System from discriminating against a student on the basis of the student's sex or sexual orientation. The UW System Board of Regents is also prohibited from investing gifts, grants, and bequests in companies that practice discrimination based on sex.

This bill seeks to add gender identity or gender expression to the list of prohibited discrimination practices in employment, housing, and the equal enjoyment of a public place of accommodation or amusement. It also seeks to add gender identity or gender expression as protected from discrimination for students at the UW System. It also prohibits the UW Board of Regents from investing gifts, grants, and bequests in companies that practice discrimination based on sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression.

The bill also adds the protections against discrimination on the basis of gender identity or gender expression for insurers.

There is no evidence that expanding these protections would increase insurance premiums or increase costs at this time. Costs would generally be minimal if any occurred.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Long-range fiscal implications would be minimal if any occurred.
