Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

No funds from the forfeitures, costs, and surcharges for tickets citing drivers for violations of s. 346.89 (3) (a) go to DOT. There is no fiscal effect on DOT.

For traffic tickets adjudicated in a circuit court, half of the forfeiture goes to the county where the citation was issued and half of the forfeiture goes to the state common school fund. For traffic tickets adjudicated in a municipal court, the forfeiture goes to the municipality.

This bill may or may not increase the number of citations for s. 346.89 (3) (a). There is an indeterminate local fiscal effect.
