## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

There is no fiscal effect on the Department of Transportation.

Local governments may see an increase in revenue from forfeitures resulting from violations of the new equipment requirements that this bill creates. The department received no notices of conviction in 2016 for violations of current law requiring the use of lights on animal-drawn vehicles during hours of darkness, so it is difficult to estimate the number of citations that might be written under this bill. The amount of this increase is indeterminate.
