Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill directs the department to work in conjunction with the Department of Justice and the Technical College System Board to establish industry specific materials for use in the instruction required by this bill.

Additional training would be needed for driver's services staff and individuals who work with commercial driver licensing, totaling approximately ten personnel. This training can be rolled into normal training at no additional cost.

The changes needed for updating training materials would be implemented by the third-party schools who provide the CDL training. The changes needed to update DMV web materials could be rolled into normal updates at no additional cost to the department.
