Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Since its inception in FY 1996, WisDOT has collected \$4,335,931 in longitudinal occupation and installation fees for telecommunications facilities located within highways, which is a FY average of \$197,088. The 10-year average over FY 2006-2016 is \$172,045. Per the Public Service Commission's underserved map (attached map), WisDOT estimates that up to 50% of its controlled-access highways (CAHs) may be affected by the bill. Many of the CAHs identified in underserved areas already have fiber installed on them via WisDOT-approved permits.

On average, WisDOT receives 10-15 requests/year from telecommunications service providers to install fiber on its CAHs. Of those requests, about 90% are charged the fee. In lieu of the occupation fee, WisDOT may receive resources in the form of unused fiber and/or conduit. On larger (longer) projects, both the telecommunications service providers and WisDOT find it advantageous to enter into a shared resource project. Therefore, most of the shorter requests for occupation on CAH involve fees.

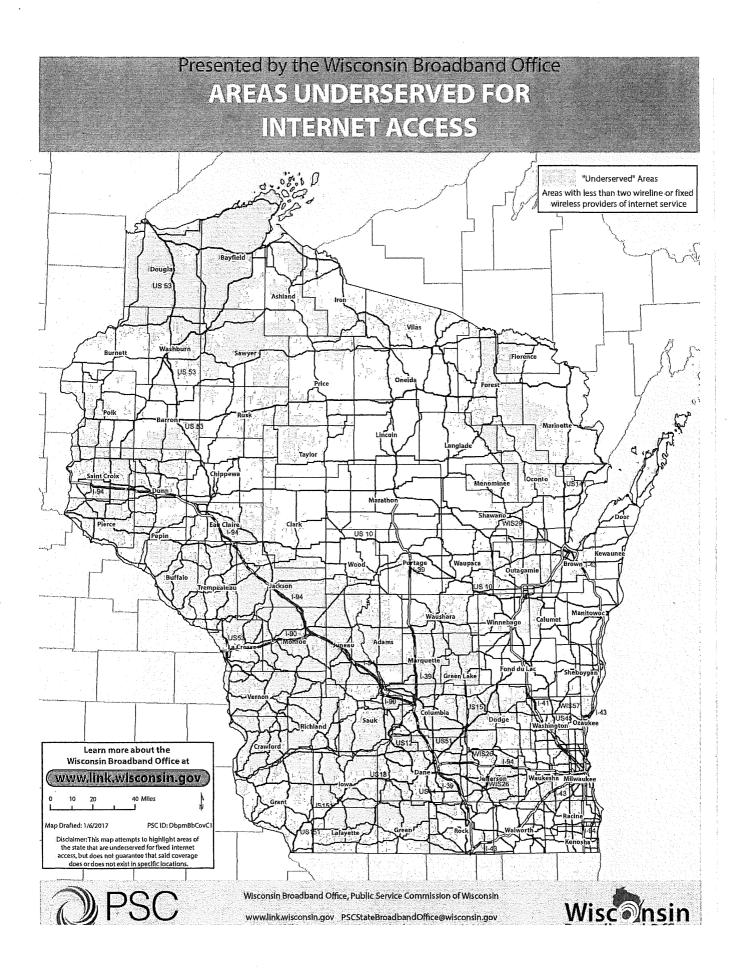
Ten-year average for longitudinal occupation and installation fees collected = \$172,045. Up to 50% of CAH's may be affected by the bill. 90% of the requests to install fiber on CAH's per year are charged a fee.

 $172,045 \times 0.9 \times 0.5 = 77,400$

WisDOT estimates that this bill will result in WisDOT collecting approximately \$75,000 less revenue per year.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Will result in decreased revenue going forward.
