Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill expands the law violations for which a juvenile may be placed in the SJOP to include any act that would be a felony if committed by an adult. It also expands the list of acts constituting prima facie evidence that the juvenile is a danger to the public and in need of restrictive placement to any act that would be a felony if committed by an adult.

Due to a lack of responses from the District Attorneys, fiscal effect on their offices is assessed as indeterminate.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

For the reasons stated above, long range fiscal impact is indeterminate.
