### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, a person who has been convicted of a crime may be ineligible for, or at a disadvantage related to, certain types of employment, occupational licensing, or occupational certification. This bill creates the Council on Offender Employment, which may issue a certificate of qualification for employment (CQE), after the convicted person applies to the council, that grants relief to the person from ineligibility for or disadvantage related to employment, occupational licensing, or occupational certification for certificates of qualification for employment if certain factors are satisfied. The council shall consist of the following 3 members: the attorney general, or his or her designee; the state public defender, or his or her designee; and the chairperson of the parole commission, or his or her designee.

Prosecutors expect no fiscal impact on their offices.
