## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill provides \$50,000 GPR to the Department of Children and Families (DCF) to develop and maintain internet-accessible training materials for county social services or veteran services workers on the appropriate response to cases involving substance abuse.

The fiscal effect for DCF is \$50,000 GPR in SFY 2019.
