Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill directs the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) to 1) develop a packet that contains information describing available employment and training opportunities, and 2) distribute a copy of this packet within two months after the beginning of each UW System semester or session to each student that was enrolled in a UW System university or college in the preceding semester but who is no longer enrolled, and did not graduate from a UW System university or college.

The information packet may present opportunities on a regional or local basis, and may include or reference materials about those opportunities that have been prepared by a technical college, a private organization providing apprenticeship training, a private organization providing training in collaboration with a technical college, or an educational institution offering a nursing program.

In order to comply with the bill's provisions DWD will create, maintain and mail a printed brochure that contains program and service information and references to web-based resources including but not limited to the Job Center of Wisconsin website. Within this website DWD plans to develop and maintain a Student Services page that will have interactive features designed to meet the needs of the bill's targeted population. The one-time first year cost for establishing the Student Services web-page is estimated at \$6,400.

The total estimated annual cost is \$30,800 GPR: \$20,300 for 420 DET staff hours; \$6,720 for tri-fold brochures, printed in color on two sides mailed in postage prepaid envelopes; and \$3,750 for maintenance of the Student Services web-page. DWD's ongoing annual cost is based on the assumption that 13,000 information packets are mailed each year. The approximate annual cost per student for the mailing and dedicated web-page is \$2.40.

Packets may include materials prepared by a private organizations The bill provides for changes to statute 20.445(1)(ga), a continuing PRO appropriation, to allow funds collected from private organizations to be received and expended. DWD may charge the private organization for the cost of printing and the proportional cost of mailing the materials. The fiscal impact from collection of program revenues from private organizations that have material included in the mailing is indeterminate.

This bill contains a sunset provision to repeal in five years after the date of the publication
