**Assembly Bill 5, January 2017 Special Session**

1. Page 9, line 8: delete "4. and (b) 4.," and substitute "4, (b) 4. and (g) 1.b.,".

2. Page 17, line 3: after that line insert:

"(g) 1. b. That there is a relationship between the alcoholic or drug dependent condition and the pattern of conduct during

the 12-month period immediately preceding the time of petition which is dangerous to the person or others and that this relationship has been established to a reasonable medical certainty.".

\*\*\*\*NOTE: The treatment of s. 51.45 (13) (g) 1. b. was inadvertently omitted.
