Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This legislation would expand eligibility for the teacher minority loan program to include Asian or Pacific Island origin students.

The legislation also modifies the eligibility criteria to allow a recipient to be eligible for loan forgiveness if he or she is employed by a public or private school in a Wisconsin school district which the minority students constitute at least 40% of the membership.

This program is administered by the Higher Education Aids Board (HEAB). The legislation would have no fiscal impact on the Wisconsin Technical College System Board or The Technical College Districts.
