Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Department to provide large metal containers where hunters may dispose of deer carcasses, to be placed in locations throughout the state. The bill also requires the Department to provide education to hunters about chronic wasting disease and the importance of proper carcass disposal. In addition, the bill provides one-time Fish & Wildlife account funding of \$1,050,000 for both FY 2020 and FY 2021 to support these efforts.

State Fiscal Effect

Expenditures for deer carcass disposal and for CWD-related hunter education efforts would be expected to increase by \$1,050,000 in both FY 2020 and FY 2021, which corresponds to the additional funding levels specified in the bill. Beyond FY 2021, the agency would need to fund the cost of disposal containers for deer carcasses, as well as education efforts for hunters about proper carcass disposal, from within its existing budget.
