Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The amendment further clarifies who may qualify for the paid internship credit and reduces the dollar amounts that may be claimed.

The bill, as amended, creates a refundable tax credit of \$1,000 for every paid intern a business employs in the state of Wisconsin, up to 5 interns. The definition of intern excludes migrant workers and individuals employed by seasonal employers or temporary help companies. The intern must be employed for at least 8 weeks, but not longer than 52 weeks and must work at least ten hours a week. This bill would take effect for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2019.

Fiscal Estimate

This amendment reduces the fiscal effect of SB014 as originally introduced by an estimated \$7.6 million in FY 2019, \$30.8 million in FY 2020, and \$31.5 million in FY 2021 for a net revenue reduction of an estimated \$5.1 million in FY 2019, \$20.5 million in FY 2020, and \$21.1 million in FY 2021.

The fiscal effect will decrease to the extent that employers only employ five or fewer paid interns.
