Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill makes it a Class H felony to commit battery against a licensed registered nurse, licensed practical nurse or individual working under the supervision of a licensed registered nurse or licensed practical nurse.

The Criminal Appeals Unit within the Division of Legal Services represents the state in all felony appeals before the Wisconsin Court of Appeals, the Wisconsin Supreme Court and the United States Supreme Court.
