#### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill requires the Department to provide self-service chronic wasting disease testing kiosks where hunters may drop off deer carcass samples for testing. The bill allows the Department to contract with private entities to conduct the testing of samples and to pay the private entity per sample tested. In addition, the bill provides one-time Fish & Wildlife account funding of \$100,000 in both FY 2020 and FY 2021 for the testing kiosks.

State Fiscal Effect

Expenditures for testing kiosks would be expected to increase by \$100,000 in FY 2020 and FY 2021, which corresponds to the additional funding levels specified in the bill. Beyond FY 2021, the agency would need to fund the cost of testing kiosks from within its existing budget.
