Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill changes the mandatory minimum period of confinement for fifth and sixth offense of OWI from 6 months in jail to 18 months in prison. This bill would have no impact on the policies of the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV), nor would it have impact on its scheduling of employees or administration of division operations.
