### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill increases annual funding for snowmobile trails and areas by \$3,000,000, from \$2,475,400 to \$5,475,400.

#### I. Fiscal Effect-State

The bill would increase annual snowmobile trail aid expenditures--funded via the snowmobile account of the conservation fund--by an estimated \$3,000,000/yr.

To the extent that the additional expenditures would exceed available revenues and thus create the potential for an account deficit, the Department would award fewer grants to ensure that the account maintains a positive year-end balance.

#### II. Fiscal Effect-Local

The bill would increase annual revenue for counties receiving snowmobile trail aids by an estimated \$3,000,000.
