Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires DNR to award up to \$100,000 in each fiscal year in grants to local governments or American Indian tribes or bands that have declared wild parsnip to be a noxious weed for projects on public or private land to map, control, eradicate, monitor, and minimize the spread of wild parsnip. The bill allows a grant recipient to collaborate with a regional conservation organization on a project funded by the grant. The bill appropriates \$50,000 annually to the Bureau of Natural Heritage Conservation (NHC) to administer the grant program.

Assumptions

The bill lacks clarity in how the \$50,000 in SEG spending authority for grants administration is to be funded; therefore, the Department assumes that the funding source would be the endangered resources account of the conservation fund, which is the account most closely connected to the NHC Bureau.

State Fiscal Effect

A. NHC operations costs will increase by an estimated \$50,000 year for a limited term employee to assist in grant-funding-application acquisition, evaluation and distribution. This coincides with the operations spending authority prescribed in the bill. Due to funding limitations of the endangered resources account of the conservation fund (e.g., license plate revenue, tax check-offs, gifts, donations, etc.), the department will have to reduce other services provided by the Bureau of Natural Heritage Conservation in order to accommodate the \$50,000/year in new administrative costs to administer the grant program.

B. Grant expenditures will increase by an estimated \$100,000/year, which coincides with the funding prescribed in the bill. Grants will be awarded to local governments or American Indian tribes or bands that have declared wild parsnip to be a noxious weed for projects on public or private land to map, control, eradicate, monitor, and minimize the spread of wild parsnip.

Local Fiscal Effect

Revenue and costs for local units of government will increase to the extent that they successfully compete for a grant. Successful parsnip eradication efforts could require local units of government to incur costs beyond the initial removal--including planting of native vegetation to out-compete wild parsnip--which may not be covered through the grant.
