Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill increases s. 20.435 (4) (b), the Department's biennial state aids appropriation to fund non-federal share of Medicaid benefits costs, by \$30.0 million GPR in SFY 24. Of this total, \$20.0 million GPR is designated to fund the state share of supplemental payments under the Medicaid program to hospitals with avoidable patient days, and \$10.0 million GPR is designated to fund an enhanced reimbursement rate under the Medicaid program for addressing the needs of nursing home residents with bariatric and extensive wound care needs. This bill also increases s. 20.435 (7) (d), a biennial state operations appropriation, by \$15.0 million GPR in SFY 24 to fund the complex patient pilot program. The net fiscal impact of this bill is an increase of \$45.0 million GPR in funds appropriated to the Department in SFY 2024. The bill also reduces the appropriation to the Joint Committee on Finance under s. 20.865 (4) (a) by \$5.0 million GPR, for a total statewide fiscal effect of \$40.0 million GPR in SFY 2024.
