#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires DNR to waive any daily fee for admission to a state park on April 22 of each year in commemoration of Earth Day.

State Fiscal Effect

#### A. Costs

The Department estimates annual, ongoing costs of \$1,000 to promote the admission fee waiver.

Staff expenses would not be impacted, as DNR staff are already on site at this time of year.

#### B. Revenue

Assuming that daily admission revenue for Earth Day ranges from \$3,000 - \$17,000, depending on the day of the week and weather conditions of any particular Earth Day, the department estimates that the fee waiver would reduce annual admission fee revenue by \$10,000 (midpoint of range).
