Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation to certify a new sales and use tax exemption for equipment or software used at a qualified data center. Qualified data centers must make a minimum investment based on county population to be certified for the exemption. The bill creates two new sections of the statutes. 1) Section 77.54 (70) defines a tax exemption for the sale of and the storage, use, or other consumption of equipment or software used at a qualified data center for the processing, storage, retrieval, or communication of data. 2) Section 238.40 defines qualified data centers, eligible data center costs, and qualified investments.

WEDC assumes additional staffing will be necessary to satisfy the administration and certification requirements outlined in the bill.

No additional funding for staffing or administration is made available through this proposal. Thus, adding these requirements to the corporation will reduce resources available for other activities and programs.
