Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, the Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) may annually grant up to \$75,000 to the Wisconsin department of the American Legion for the operation of Camp American Legion. This bill increases the amount the department may grant to the Camp American Legion to \$120,000. This bill could increase expenditures for the Department in the amount of \$45,000. This grant is funded from the Veterans Trust Fund (VTF), which in turn is funded by GPR from the Department of Administration (DOA) appropriation 4(bv), numeric 85500. This increase cost would require DVA to request additional GPR to fund the VTF.
