Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would prohibit certain felony offenders from possessing, controlling, or residing with a vicious dog, as determined by a humane officer or a law enforcement officer using criteria specified in the bill.

DATCP staff would need to add applicable information to the current humane officer training, but the time to do so would be small and could be absorbed into an existing position.
