## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill allows the department to research chronic wasting disease (CWD) in cervids, which is any species of deer or elk that is present in the wild and that is not a farm-raised deer. In addition, it allows the department to manage and provide funding to conduct testing for CWD. Finally, the bill provides \$1.0 million of annual, ongoing GPR funding for the research and management of CWD.

State Fiscal Effect

Annual expenditures for the research and management of CWD are estimated to increase by \$1.0 million, which corresponds to the GPR funding provided in the bill.
