#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill allows the department to use two existing Environment Fund appropriations--one for recycling administration and one for general program operations--for the existing statewide program to educate government employees, businesses, and the general public about the state's solid waste reduction, recovery, and recycling programs.

#### Fiscal Effect

The bill has no fiscal impact, but provides the department with greater flexibility and clarifies its authority to use the recycling appropriation for its intended purposes.
