Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires the Department of Revenue to place on income tax forms a method by which a resident of this state who is 15 years of age or older, or an emancipated minor, may elect to include his or her name as a donor of an anatomical gift in the record of potential donors maintained by the Department of Transportation (donor registry).

The bill has no fiscal impact on the Department of Natural Resources.
