Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates the Council for Equity and Inclusion and the Office for Equity and Inclusion at the Department of Administration and creates Equity and Inclusion Officers at state agencies, including the Department of Transportation. If passed, the proposed bill would create 1.0 FTE in appropriation s. 20.395(4)(aq), but adds no expenditure authority to pay for the newly-created position. The estimated annual fiscal impact on the Department is \$81,700 (includes salary, fringe, and supplies and services). The Department could not absorb this additional cost.

It is unknown if the bill's requirement to create an annual report of the Council's activities would create additional costs for the Department.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

This bill would add annual expenditures based associated with the addition of the Equity Officer 1.0 in the estimated amount of \$81,700. The Department could not absorb this additional cost and would require increased expenditure authority in appropriation s. 20.395(4)(aq).
