Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates the Council for Equity and Inclusion and the Office for Equity and Inclusion, both attached to the Department of Administration (DOA).

Under the bill, the head of each executive branch entity represented on the Council for Equity and Inclusion (which includes the State Superintendent of Public Instruction) must appoint an officer for equity and inclusion, and each such officer must develop and implement an annual plan for equity and inclusion that must be submitted to the council for review and approval.

The bill also authorizes four full-time equivalent GPR positions for the Office for Equity and Inclusion (DOA) and one full-time equivalent position for each of the executive branch entities represented on the Council for Equity and Inclusion. Thus, under the bill, DPI would receive 1.0 FTE permanent GPR position.

The bill does not increase DPI's appropriation for general program operations for the additional position authority. The estimated costs for a 1.0 FTE Equity and Inclusion Officer is \$124,800 annually, for salary, fringe benefits, fixed costs, IT/desktop support, and travel. Absent additional budget authority provided in FY24 or FY25, DPI would have to reallocate GPR resources to absorb the costs associated with an E&I Officer position. The costs associated with the position would be included in DPI's FY25 adjusted base appropriations, and therefore, would be funded via the standard budget adjustment process as part of the 2025-27 biennial budget.
