Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill adds an additional requirement to public contracts entered into by local units of government, defined as a city, village, town, or county. Under the bill, these public contracts must contain a provision that the contractor will use materials that are manufactured in the United States in the performance of the contract.

The fiscal estimate is indeterminate as the department does not have detailed purchasing data on the country-of-origin contents for materials purchased by local governments.

The department does not have any administrative costs.
