Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Currently, the Department provides up to \$69,100 GPR annually through the appropriation under s. 20.435 (1) (eg) for pregnancy counseling as described under s. 253.08.

Under SB 345, the appropriation under s.20.435 (1)(eg) would increase by \$1,000,0000 annually, to be granted out to Choose Life Wisconsin Inc., which would then be required to grant up to \$50,000 to crisis pregnancy centers who apply for the funds. The proposal requires Choose Life Wisconsin to report to the Department annually. In order to provide technical assistance toward the development of the annual report, as well provide general grant management support, the Department estimates the need for 0.5 FTE Grants Specialist-Adv for a cost of \$37,500 GPR annually. In total, the Department expects the cost of this bill to be \$1,037,500 GPR per year.
