Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Senate Bill 482 would provide the Department of Administration (Department) with \$411,500,000 in funding from Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-24 to FY 2045-46 to make sum sufficient payments to a local professional baseball park district to assist with its development, construction, repair, and maintenance. The payment amount is determined by an annualized schedule. In addition, an amount of \$50,000,000 would be provided to fund short-term loans awarded by the Department to a local professional baseball park district under the same purpose.

The amounts for the grant payments and loan program would be funded through the sum sufficient appropriations newly created under this bill. The Department would be responsible for administering, monitoring, and providing fiscal management of the grant funding and loan programs. The Department is not able to estimate if the increase to its workload would be able to be absorbed under current existing Departmental position authority and funding.
